### Retreat Rules

1. The finest Christian behavior is expected of campers at all times.
2. All campers must punctually attend all functions, including meals.
3. Beach robes or other appropriate covering must be worn to and from the swimming pool.
4. Two-piece swimsuits may be worn only if covered by a non-see-through T-shirt.
5. Because of the rough terrain, shoes must be worn at all times (except when playing volleyball).
6. Electronic devices (cell phones, music players, etc) must be left with a counselor during the retreat.
7. No pranks involving shaving cream, toothpaste, or towel popping is allowed at any time for any reason.
8. Campers are not allowed to bring balloons for any reason.
9. No fireworks are allowed.
10. Any individual damaging property will be held responsible and charged for any cost for the damage.
11. Cabins, worship areas, and all grounds will be kept clean. Otherwise, fellowship time will become cleanup time.
12. There will be no type of physical contact between boys and girls.
13. No tobacco products may be used by any camper during the retreat.
14. Campers will be sent home for the following reasons:
  - Entering the cabin of the opposite sex
  - Missing from the cabin after curfew without permission
  - Leaving the campgrounds without permission
15. No body piercing jewelry is permitted except for earrings. Although it is not mandatory, it would be appreciated if boys did not wear them during the retreat.
16. No type of offensive, derogatory, obscene, or objectionable language or pictures on clothing will be allowed.
17. Campers may not wear their pants below the waist with their underwear showing.
18. If a camper wishes to do something which is not specifically covered by a stated rule, he/she must first ask his/her cabin leader.

### What to Bring:

Every camper will need sheets and blankets for a twin-sized bunk or a sleeping bag (no slick/nylon sleeping bags, please), hygiene articles, towels, changes of clothing (according to the dress code), Bible, notebook, pencil, flashlight, swimsuit and a GREAT CHRISTIAN ATTITUDE.

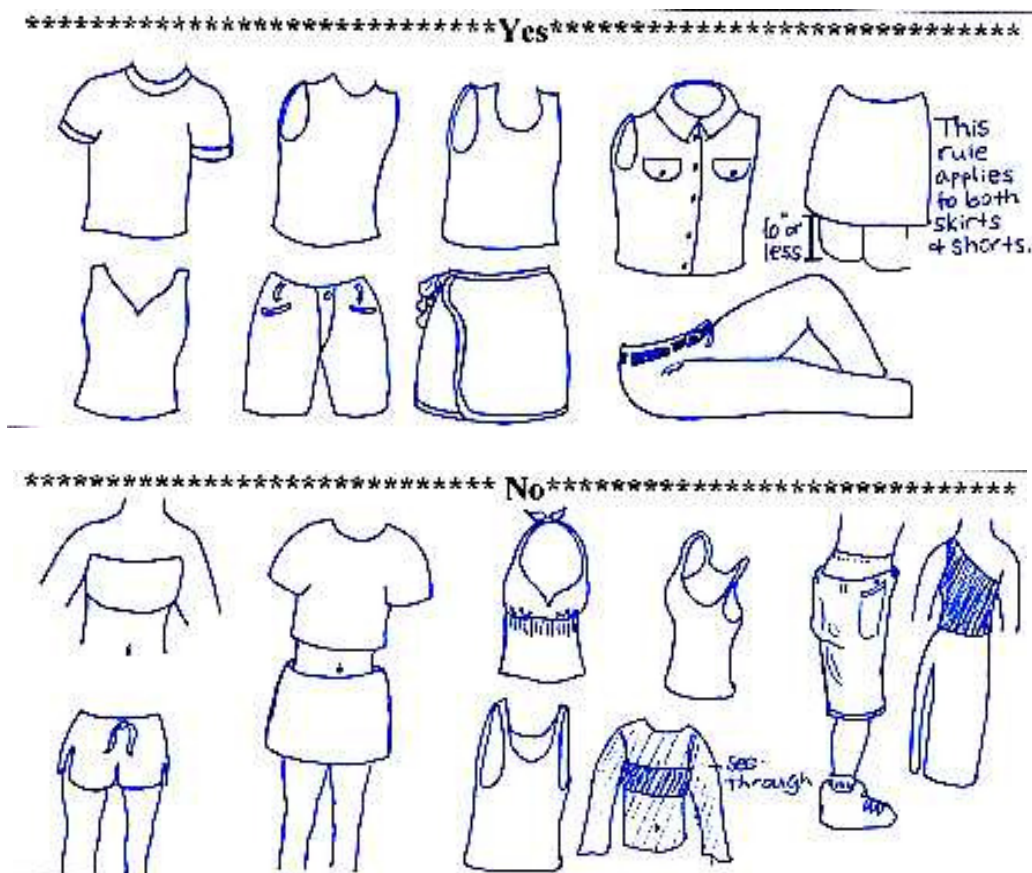

## Dress Code

Youth are expected to dress MODESTLY at all times. Bare shoulders, backs, or midriffs are not allowed during the retreat for either boys or girls. If shorts are worn, they cannot be shorter than those shown in the “Yes” illustration below. Shorts (which may be worn at all times during the retreat) must also be hemmed (no cut-offs) and cannot have slits that interfere with this minimum length. Your appearance matters to God.
